PE Kits All the children in Y1-Y6 have a statutory entitlement to participate in 2 hours a week of PE. PE covers:

In KS1 movement skills around agility, balance and co-ordination, there is a focus on team games and there are dance units.

In KS2 the children look at different types of games, develop their athletic and gymnastic skills. There is a focus on dance, they all participate in outdoor & adventurous activities (OAA) and participate in swimming & look at water safety.

It is important that the children do have their PE kits in school. Their kit could come in on a Monday and go home on Friday, or stay in school for a half term. (It does not work when kit is brought in daily as it is often forgotten!)
