


Going Back to School



Which class will I be in?

You will get to say "Hello" to the teacher you had last year in September to catch up on your news before meeting your new class teacher.




Will I be with my friends?

You will be with children you know in your class. You will only be with these children when you're at school, even at playtime.




What do I need to bring to school and what do I wear?

What will my classroom look like?

Everyone needs to sit facing the front. You will have your set space at a table.



Will I go outside at playtime?

All classes will have an outside area you can play in with the children from your class (or bubble). You will have your own class equipment to play with. You will be asked to play games where you don't touch each other.





What will happen at lunchtime?

Each class will have a different time to eat which your teacher will tell you about. If it is raining, you will have an indoor playtime in your classroom. You can still chat to your friends




How will my teachers keep me safe?

You will wash your hands when you get to school, and at least before and after playtime and lunchtime (and after you have been to the toilet of course!). You will be outside as much as possible getting fresh air. There will be lots of cleaning and wiping. There will not be any soft toys or cushions in your classrooms, as they can't be cleaned easily. You will stay away from others as much as you can.



Will I still get help if I need it?

Of course you will. Your teacher may have to use the interactive whiteboard to show you things to help you or show you things from a little bit further away than before but they will still help you when you are stuck, hurt or sad.



Will we still have fun?

Everybody at school wants to make sure you are safe and happy while still doing your learning and seeing your friends. We just need to make sure everyone follows the rules to keep each other safe, but we can still have fun.



What about before and after school clubs?

As the government is asking for everyone to stay in their class bubbles and not mix this makes any clubs tricky. There is also strict guidance out about PE clubs. Hopefully clubs can start again after the October half term.
