- Moving carefully and steadily to avoid collisions.

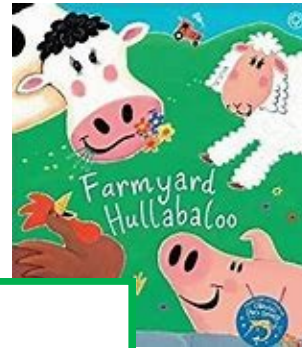


### Numeracy

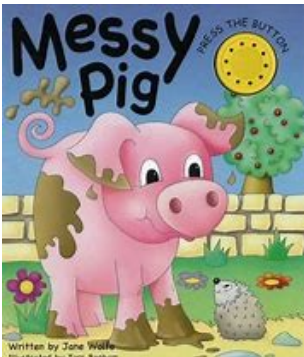


### Literacy
